## Food Vendor Rules and Regulations

**Event will go on Rain or Shine. No refunds will be given for any reason.**

**Set-Up:** Begins at 8:30am on event day. Vendors must be completely set up by 10:00am with all vehicles out of the event space. Designated parking will be provided. Due to food hold times, food sales may be delayed until 11:00am at the vendors discretion.

Vendors are required to staff their booth space the entire duration of the event.

**Take-Down:** Begins at 5:00pm on event day. No early take-down allowed. Vendors must remove all items and leave space clean.

**Booths:** A 10' wide x 15' deep booth space will be provided. Vendors must provide table(s), chairs, shade tent, equipment and staff. Vendors must ensure that none of their display equipment extends beyond the space they have booked; this includes any rails, stands or additional equipment.

Due to event space limitations, power hook-up is not available. Access to water will be available. Vendors must bring their own containers to transport water to their booths. No Direct water hook-ups are available.

- Only one (1) business per booth. Space may not be sublet or shared. Cost is \$150.00 per space. Cost for Food Trucks is \$225.00 per vehicle.
- Cash, check or money orders are accepted with registration form. Payment through PayPal is available. Please contact the Booster President for additional information.
- The South Rowan Band Boosters Board will strive to have only one vendor per type of food sold. If you have any concerns in this area, please contact the Board before submitting your application.
- Each Vendor is responsible for assuring safety and security in and around their booth in a manner that minimizes risk or hazards to the public and their own belongings.

- Only items listed and approved on the vendor application are permitted for sale in the booth space. All other items are strictly prohibited.
- Acquisition of sales tax permits, collection of sales tax, and reporting tax revenues are the responsibility of the vendor.
- All Food Vendors will be required to have their Sanitation Grade posted. Temporary Food Permits are available from the Rowan County Health Department. Information and forms may be obtained at: <https://www.rowancountync.gov/292/Food-Lodging-Sanitation>
- Non-profit/Exempt organizations will be required to provide proof of their exempt status.
- All Food Vendors must follow established guidelines by the Rowan County Health Department.
- All Food Vendors are required to submit a current updated Certificate of Insurance at least 7 days prior to the event. Failure to do so may result in the Vendor not being allowed to participate in the event and forfeiture of application fee.
