Vendor Rules and Regulations

Event will go on Rain or Shine. No refunds will be given for any reason.

Set-Up: Begins at 8:30am on event day. Vendors must be completely set up by 10:00am with all vehicles out of the event space. Designated parking will be provided.

Vendors are required to staff their booth space the entire duration of the event.

Take-Down: Begins at 5:00pm on event day. No early take-down allowed. Vendors must remove all items and leave space clean.

Booths: A 10' wide x 15' deep booth space will be provided. Vendors must provide table(s), chairs, shade tent, equipment and staff. Vendors must ensure that none of their display equipment extends beyond the space they have booked; this includes any rails, stands or additional equipment.

- Only one (1) business per booth. Space may not be sublet or shared. Cost is \$60.00 per space. Cash, check or money orders are accepted with registration form. Payment through PayPal is available. Click on the Payment link on our website: <https://www.raiderregimentsrhs.com/bbq-throwdown.html>.
- The South Rowan Band Boosters Board will strive to have only one vendor per organization of manufactured goods (ie. Paparazzi, Avon etc) however, there may be multiple vendors in a particular category (ie. Jewelry, Make-Up etc). There will be no limitation on the number or type of vendors displaying handmade crafts. If you have any concerns in this area, please contact the Board before submitting your application.
- Each Vendor is responsible for assuring safety and security in and around their booth in a manner that minimizes risk or hazards to the public and their own belongings.
- Only items listed and approved on the vendor application are permitted for sale in the booth space. All other items are strictly prohibited.
- Acquisition of sales tax permits, collection of sales tax, and reporting tax revenues are the responsibility of the vendor.
